Careers Education also involves input from outside sources and visiting speakers eg talks from alumni, Joined up Careers, local industry and apprenticeship providers. We employ a dedicated Careers Adviser who interviews all the pupils in KS4 on a 'one to one' basis, with the addition of interviews offered to certain year 9 pupils. We are always adapting and improving our schemes of work to suit the future requirements of Further Education and Employment.
