## Key Knowledge for Year 11 in RE

### Term 1

- The nature of the Church, the role of Mary as a model of the Church, the Church as the body of Christ, the church as the people of God. Salvation and the Church, the main features of a church that reflect the belief in Salvation. How the Sacraments lead us to salvation. The need for evangelisation.
- Theme 4 – Life and Death. What do Catholics believe about death, end of life care and assisted suicide/Euthanasia

### Term 2

- Catholic teachings about Heaven and Hell, The Magisterium and Second Vatican Council
- Artefacts to express faith in the resurrection and the afterlife – Sarcophagi and the Easter (Paschal candle)
- The significance of different forms of music in Worship and especially in Catholic funeral rites. The significance of prayer within Catholic communities, formulaic and extempore prayer and praying for the dead.

### Term 3

- Revision and recall. Preparation for the final exams

Presentation from the Life group on Abortion and Euthanasia.

Use film and documentaries to explore the wider issues e.g. Dead Man Walking, Choosing to die (Terry Pratchett), and a short stay in Switzerland.

<u>Word</u>	<u>Meaning</u>
Death	The end of Physical life
Eternal Life	Life in Heaven after death
Heaven	eternal life for those who have Accepted God's grace and forgiveness in this life.
Hell	living eternally outside God's presence
Judgement	when an individual is held to account by God for the things they have done.
Magisterium	The teaching authority of the Church
